Dear Judge Black:

This report is being submitted to the Court pursuant to 22 O.S. 982(a), which provides for a 12-month Judicial Review for consideration of sentence modification. The hearing must be held prior to *December 21, 2008*.

On the 21st day of December 2007, the court sentenced Ms. Hernandez to a term of twenty-five- (25) years to serve with ten-(10)-years suspended in the custody of the Department of Corrections pursuant to a finding of guilt for the offense of *Second Degree Murder*.

On February 07, 2008, she was received at the Mabel Bassett Assessment and Reception Center (MBARC). According to the information compiled at MBARC, she had assessed programmatic needs of Education, Substance Abuse Education and Cognitive Behavior classes as determined by a Level of Service Inventory (LSI- R) Revised risk score. She was then transferred to her destination.

As of February 27, 2008, she was transferred to the Mabel Bassett Correctional Center, and ordered to attend the Substance Abuse Treatment Program-(SAT).

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According to her case manager, Ms. Hernandez began her classes on March 19, 2008. Her case manager reports that she has completed the following classes:

Phase I- Introduction/Orientation - to establish rules & regulations of the program.

Phase II- Treatment classes:
(Changing attitudes & behaviors)

Education- She began her Education in July 2008, with outstanding evaluations. Ms. Hernandez is currently attending Adult Basic Education-(ABE), with no reported problems. She has not been able to complete her GED at this time.

"Thinking for A Change"- (cognitive behavior class dealing with self change, problem solving, social skills and character building- completed - 7/22/08).

Life Skills- basic skills for leading a positive life style - (completed).

Domestic Violence- dealing with alternative to abuse in relationships-(completed).

Substance Abuse Treatment- group counseling & treatment sessions-(completed- 8/18/08).

Phase III- Discharge/Relapse-

"Parenting from within"- basic skills & techniques for raising children-(6/08).

HIV Peer Education- identification, prevention of HIV and other diseases-(completed-(8/08).

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According to her case manager, Ms. Hernandez has been doing an outstanding job at this facility. She has participated in all classes made available to her. Ms. Hernandez has been very cooperative; interacts well with staff and her peers. In fact, she has not had any behavioral issues; has not received any negative incidents or misconduct reports. The program director states that Ms. Hernandez has maintained a positive attitude, has continued to work on her self-esteem and has maintained a 100% on her "Behavioral Contract". She was the "Top 3 Star Winner" for a class called "Reach for the Stars". In addition, she has been the "student of the month" for several months. Ms. Hernandez received an award during the graduation ceremony for being the "Reach for the Stars" winner, and was also the top graduate of her class. Ms. Hernandez has been a "mentor" for SAT since her graduation and the program director is very proud of her efforts and hard work. On October 15, 2008, Ms. Hernandez completed the SAT Program with great success.

She has been promoted to earned credit level four- (L-4), for privileges. As of November 07, 2008, she has 3948 remaining to serve on her sentence and has a parole hearing by the Pardon and Parole during the April 2017 docket.
