Terminated

1. Cook, Alan: Probationary officer that was involved in an off-duty disturbance where he threatened bodily harm.
2. Harbison, Cody: Probationary officer that obtained prescription pain medications without a prescription.
3. Sumpter, Michael: Probationary officer that was arrested for Domestic Violence in the presence of a child.

Demoted

1. Merits, Matt: Inappropriate on-duty conduct and manipulated his patrol vehicle Automatic Vehicle Locator to avoid being located.
2. Garnett, Kelly: Compensated by the city for time he was not at work.

Days Off Without Pay/Class III Reprimand

1. Germany, Anthony: Arrested for driving under the influence while off-duty.
2. Ricketts, William S.: Was involved in an unjustified use of force incident while on-duty.
3. Torres, Frank: Failed to report a use of force incident while on-duty.
4. Elliot, Jarrod: Admitted to use of steroids.
5. McCaleb, Mark: Involved in an off-duty assault and battery and failed to report the incident to his supervisor.

6. Dewberry, Vincent: Operated his police vehicle in an unsafe manner while on-duty that resulted in an injury accident.
7. Martinez, Roger: Operated his police vehicle in an unsafe manner while on-duty that resulted in an injury accident.
8. Ramming, Chris: Found to be under the influence of alcohol while on-duty.
9. Dawson, Mike: Arrested by Logan County for public drunkenness and kicked out the windows of the deputy's vehicle.
10. Paull, John: Operated his police vehicle in an unsafe manner while responding to a call for service that resulted in a fatality accident.
11. Hurd, Vanessa: Involved in four (4) preventable on-duty vehicle collisions.
12. Cunningham, Lauren: Violated OCPD policy when she made an inaccurate statement in a police report.
13. Hinton, Travis: Used inappropriate force and language with a citizen and failed to report the incident to his supervisor.
14. Engles, Craig: Operating his police vehicle on multiple occasions at a high rate of speed without cause.
15. Fale, Jeff: Involved in four (4) preventable on-duty vehicle collisions.
