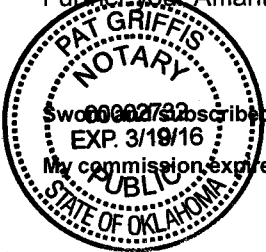
I, Ronald Collett, the Affiant, being first duly sworn, upon oath, deposes and says:

That I am a duly sworn and authorized peace officer for the City of Norman, County of Cleveland, State of Oklahoma and was acting in that capacity at all times mentioned herein.

On Tuesday, October 9 2012 at approximately 9:50 p. m., the victim parked her pickup in an empty driveway near 207 East Johnson, the home of her boyfriend and his wife, defendant Virginia Davis. The victim, believing that her boyfriend was inside with his wife, recruited their friend to go to the door of the home to see if he could obtain some money from her boyfriend so that they could go buy beer and cigarettes. While waiting, the victim saw the defendant (who she has known for one year), approach her pickup, raise a pistol and shoot her through the closed window of the pickup's driver's side door. The victim then pulled her pickup out of the drive and moved it to the intersection of Peters Avenue and Johnson Street where she came to a stop and sounded the horn until a passerby arrived.

Based on the foregoing facts, your Affiant prays that this honorable court issue a finding of fact that probable cause exists to believe that the crime **ASSAULT AND BATTERY WITH A DEADLY WEAPON** did occur near the residence located at **207 EAST JOHNSON STREET** within the City of Norman, County of Cleveland, State of Oklahoma. Further that the said offenses were committed by the defendant **VIRGINIA RUTH DAVIS**, contrary to the law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma. Your Affiant requests that the defendant be held for bond. The Affiant swears and affirms that the above information is true and correct.

That the affiant is employed by the Norman Police Department, Patrol Division I.

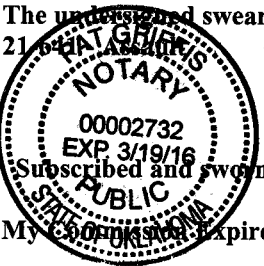
That on or about 12/13/12, at the Norman Police Department, Cleveland County, Norman, Oklahoma, the undersigned further states as follows:
