I, Sean Thompson, the affiant, a Police Detective in and for the City of Warr Acres Police Department, certified as a peace officer by the State of Oklahoma, do upon my oath allege and state as follows:

That on 07-02-12 at approximately 0807 hours, Officers were dispatched to 5944 NW 40<sup>th</sup> #102 in reference to a suspicious death investigation. The reporting party advised that her son's girlfriend was dead and that she thought he did it, and that he was still present. Officers arrived and made contact with the reporting party and the suspect. The reporting party, Brenda Sykes, walked her son, Charles Joe Sykes, over to Officers and advised, "He killed his girlfriend". Charles Sykes was shaking his head in the affirmative, and admitted to Lt. Green that he had choked her to death at about 0300 hours. Charles Sykes was taken into custody at this time. Detective Sergeant Gray and I interviewed Sykes, under Miranda, at the police station. Sykes admitted to arguing and fighting with the victim, identified as Raeviana Satterfield, and during the fight, placing her in a headlock choke hold. Sykes said that he applied pressure around her neck by squeezing his arm, and lifting upward. Sykes said that he held the hold until Satterfield stopped struggling. Sykes said that he checked Satterfield and realized she was dead. Sykes then wrapped Satterfield in bedsheets and placed her in the bathtub.

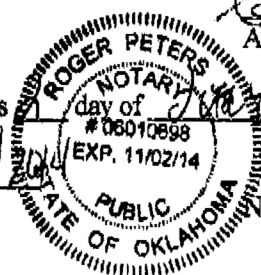
This incident occurred within the City of Warr Acres, Oklahoma County, and State of Oklahoma.
