Narrative

On 12-10-2008, at approximately 1730 hrs, I (Ofc Slor, #8965) responded to 605 S. Sparks St, regarding a residential burglary.

Upon arrival, I met with V/JONES, Larrie, who told me that she was recently terminated from the position of Vice President and General Counsel for the organization known as Feed The Children. JONES stated that her parents had her fired when she attempted to implement new federal guidelines for charity organizations. JONES stated that the organization does not want to implement the guidelines as it limits their fund raising activities. When JONES attempted follow federal rules, she was fired by the organization.

Narrative

JONES stated that the Feed The Children organization owns her residence at 605 S. Sparks St. Since her parents founded the organization, she was given the residence to live in. JONES stated that on 12-4-2008, she flew to the organization's headquarters in Oklahoma City, Ok. She left her residence on Sparks St at approximately 0800 hrs. During her meetings in Oklahoma City, JONES was fired from the organization. When she returned home on 12-10-2008, at approximately 1600 hrs, she discovered that an unknown person(s) had entered her residence, and stole an organization owned laptop computer, an external hard drive, and other related components. The suspect(s) also stole personal papers from a briefcase in her office. JONES stated that the papers were legal papers not related to the organization.

JONES led me outside to the south side of the residence. JONES directed me to a bathroom window with a screen removed. Observed that the suspect(s) removed the screen and attempted to open the window. Since the window was closed and locked, it is unknown if the suspects accessed the residence through this window.

JONES told me that she believed that the organization sent personnel to take the computer and related components. As they removed the components, they also stole her personal papers believing that they were organization related. JONES stated that she believed that organization Human Resources Director, PIVGRAY, Richard, knew of the incident and has knowledge that the organization had sent personnel to enter the residence.

JONES gave me GRAY's telephone number and I called him. GRAY told me that he did not exactly know if the organization sent somebody to break into the residence, but gave me a telephone number of a female named "Pam" at (317) 339-6930. I telephoned this number, but nobody answered. A short time later GRAY called back and stated, "Someone did enter the house. An FTC (Feed The Children) employee did." I asked GRAY why they entered a private residence and he stated, "Larrie Jones had been fired from the organization. She is trespassing on the property and we have a right to enter and take our property." GRAY did not elaborate on who the organization sent to break into the residence. I informed GRAY that the residence is a home belonging to JONES and that what the organization is not allowed to enter and take any property. Until she moves or is evicted through a legal process, the house is private residence. I advised him what the persons who entered the residence committed a residential burglary. GRAY stated that he understood and he would attempt to return the property to JONES.

JONES has speculated that the organization thought there was important data on the laptop computer, which they needed. JONES stated that she did not use the computer and the data they were seeking was on another laptop, which she has possession of.

JONES added that she gave nobody permission to enter her residence and take her personal papers. While the laptop and associated computer components belong to Feed The Children, they needed to simply ask her for the property. Instead, the organization dispatched personnel to break into her house and steal it and her paperwork.

There was no FS on duty to take latent prints. The BPD desk left a request for prints on their answering machine.
