











Which opponent playing a Big XII team this week was originally an institution of higher education for females?









Which university mascot has direct ties to Spanish explorers?











Most people associate damaging tornadoes with Oklahoma, but the most destructive tornado on record actually occurred in which state?




The Rio Grande is the third longest river system in the United States and is an important river in the Southwest. Name the sources and the mouth of the Rio Grande, and their approximate locations.


The dome of what Big XII city's capitol building actually stands taller than that of the Nation's Capitol in Washington D.C.?











Which university playing in the Big XII this week has a piece of Blarney Stone from the original Blarney Castle in Ireland? Why?
