

Automobile Liability

Coverage Required: \$1,000,000

If a licensee of the Convention Center will be driving any type of vehicle onto Convention Center property, automobile liability insurance is required in the event of an accident resulting in bodily injury or property damage caused by a vehicle the licensee owns, rents or hires.

Commercial General Liability

Coverage Required: \$1,000,000

If a licensee of the Convention Center leases space on the property, the licensee must provide proof of commercial general liability insurance in the event the licensee, his/her employees or attendees should cause an accident resulting in bodily injury or property damage caused by their actions or non-actions.

Workers' Compensation

Coverage Required: Insurance meeting the statutory requirements of the State of North Carolina and any applicable Federal laws; and, Employers' Liability - \$100,000 per accident limit, \$500,000 disease per policy limit, \$100,000 disease each employee limit.

If a licensee employee should be on the property to make a delivery, host a show, set up a show, etc. at the Convention Center, workers' compensation coverage is required to protect employees of the licensee for bodily injury or disease arising out of and in the course of their employment. A licensee of the Convention Center that is an employer with three or more employees is required by North Carolina law to provide workers' compensation for his/her employees. The above requirements are subject to change. Consult your Convention Center Sales Manager or Event Manager for details.

NOTE: The certificate you provide must name the Charlotte Regional Visitors Authority as additional insured.
