

## Automobile Liability

### Coverage Required: \$1,000,000

If a licensee of the Convention Center, and/or its contractors, will be driving any type of vehicle onto Convention Center property, automobile liability insurance is required in the event of an accident resulting in bodily injury or property damage caused by a vehicle the licensee and/or contractor owns, rents or hires.

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## Commercial General Liability

### Coverage Required: \$1,000,000

Licenses of the Convention Center must provide proof of Commercial General Liability (CGL) insurance in the event the licensee, their employees, contractors or attendees cause bodily injury or property damage by their actions or non-actions.

The required Certificate of Insurance (COI) for the CGL coverage provided by the Licensee must name the Charlotte Regional Visitors Authority, its officers, employees, agents, assigns and the City of Charlotte as Additional Insured and the Charlotte Regional Visitors Authority as Certificate Holder.

The "Insured" name on the COI must match the "Customer" name as it appears on the License Agreement.

## Workers' Compensation

Coverage Required: Insurance meeting the statutory requirements of the State of North Carolina and any applicable Federal laws; and, Employers' Liability - \$100,000 per accident limit, \$500,000 disease per policy limit, \$100,000 disease each employee limit.

If a licensee's or their contractors' employees should be on Convention Center property to make a delivery, host or set up a show, etc., Workers' Compensation coverage is required to protect those employees for bodily injury or disease arising out of and in the course of their employment. Licensees of the Convention Center and their contractors that employ three or more employees are required by North Carolina law to provide Workers' Compensation for their employees. The above requirements are subject to change according to applicable law.
