A copy of the discharge (DD214) is required with submission of application.

Payment is also required at time of submission (cash or check).

Memorial is made of black granite.

It takes fourteen paid complete applications to create a memorial block.

Placement of the memorial is dependent upon which holiday it is created closest to – Memorial Day or Veterans Day.

All applications, discharge documents and payments will be submitted to White's Funeral Home during the business hours of Monday to Friday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
