Roll 1-3 FIRST PICTURE OF BOYCOTT AGAINST GERMAN JEWS Goebbels, Dr. (Jew boycott)

Date: 1 April 1933 Fox Movietone News

Minister of Propaganda *Goebbels* addresses stormtroopers to defend themselves against Jewish propaganda. He declares: "This morning at 10 o'clock the boycott started like a thunderbolt and was performed with discipline. It will be finished at twelve midnight." Scenes show Nazi troopers wrecking various Jewish stores, placard shops in Berlin Tauentzienstrasse and propaganda choruses exhort street crowds.

1 April 1933

Roll 3-3 NAZIS BURN BOOKS OF NOTED WRITERS IN GREAT BONFIRE

Goebbels, Dr. (Nazis burn books)

Date: 10 May 1933 Hearst Metrotone News

Jewish, Socialist and Marxist authors, including pacifists, are banned and their books burned in a huge pyre in the Unter den Linden in Berlin. Students of Berlin University troop to scene, carrying torches, torchlight procession. Scenes of books burning. Dr. Joseph Goebbels makes a speech. (Note: The speech is cut out).

10 May 1933

Roll 3-1 SAILORS, KILLED BY SPANISH, BROUGHT HOME TO GERMANY Hitler, Adolf (Sailors buried)

Date: 18 June 1937

The "Deutschland" nearing Wilhelmshaven with the flag-draped coffins on board. The coffins are transferred to the Wilhelmshaven cemetery where services are held. Admiral Raeder speaks in the presence of Hitler and von Blomberg. Hitler places a wreath and extends his sympathy to some of the deceased's relatives. Von Blomberg places wreath. The wreath placed by Blomberg carries a large ribbon with the inscription "DER REICHSKRIEGSMINISTER" (Minister of War of the German Reich).

18 June 1937

Roll 3 - 4 DR. GOEBBELS STIRS HOME TOWN ON VISIT TO RHEYDT

Goebbels, Dr. (vast throng hears) Date: 24 April 1933

Rheydt is Dr. Goebbels home town. He visits school which he attended in his youth. A children's choir sings. The mayor of Rheydt delivers a speech. A crowd as far as the eye can see waits outside the City Hall to hear Dr. Goebbels who addresses them through loudspeakers. The vast throng sings "Deutschland ueber Alles."

24 April 1933

Roll 3-5 HITLER'S BIRTHDAY MARKED BY PRESENT OF AIR SQUADRON Goering, General (Hitler's birthday)

Date: 20 April 1933

Hitler with General Goering in garden of chancery. Band playing Badenweiler March. Minister Frick with Staff Chief Lutze and Chief Group Leader Dietrich. Group Leader Bruckner talking to naval officer. German troops before Hitler, Hitler passing Company of Honor. At Staaken Hitler receives airplane squadron as gift from Storm Detachments. Hitler starting flight to Berchtesgaden. plane over camera.)

20 April 1935

Roll 4-1 HITLER ASSEMBLES REICHSTAG

Goering, Hermann (Hitler assembles Reichstag)

Date: 18 March 1938

Field-Marshal Goering opened the meeting. Hitler spoke explaining his steps in Vienna. He dissolved the Reichstag and set April 10 as the date of the new Reichstag election. He gives a survey of the first five years of his European policy. He declares that no power in the world would allow itself to be dismembered of its homeland (Austria). He declares himself to be the executor of the German will in bringing back Austria to the Fatherland. Goering spoke the closing words: "Ein Volk, Ein Reich, Deutschland Sieg Heil." (One people of German blood, one Reich, Victory Hurray.)

18 March 1938

GAL TWO

HITLER PRESENTS FLAGS TO ARMY, NAVY AND AIRFORCE Roll 5 - 1 Goering, Col. Gen. (Hitler, flags)

Date: 19 April 1937

Presentation takes place in the Wilhelm Platz. Divisions of the Army, Navy and Air Forces lined the square. Hitler presents flags to commander of each division, with whom he shakes hands. The Führer and Gen. Field Marshal von Blomberg speak. Present are General Admiral Raeder, Col. Gen. Goering, Col. Gen. von Fritsch. In the picture are to be seen foreign diplomats with their families. In the foreground of the diplomat's box, Dr. Hjalmar Schacht in civilian clothes, next to him Ley, wearing SA uniform. Political gauleiters standing in one row.

19 April 1937

GERMAN-ITALIAN ALLIANCE PACT SIGNED Roll 5 - 2

Goering, Hermann (German-Italian)

Date: 21 May 1939

Arriving at Anhalter Station, Count Ciano welcomed by Ribbentrop. Crowds line streets and give cheering welcome. At Unknown Soldier's tomb, Ciano places a wreath. In the Ambassador's Room of the New Reich Chancellery, Ciano and Ribbentrop sign documents. Goering, Raeder, Brauchitsch, Keitel, Mackensen, Ambassador Attolico present. Ribbentrop's talk: "150 million Germans and Italians are forming a bloc, invincible in the world, under the unique leadership of Adolf Hitler and Benito Mussolini."

21 May 1939

MAY FIRST CELEBRATION Roll 6-1

Goering, Gen. (May Day celebration, Berlin)

Date: 1 May 1936

Youths gather in Post Stadiums. Hitler arrives, circles the arena. Baldur von Schirach, Reichs Youth Leader, greets Hitler, Führer speaks. Singing of Hitler Youth Song.

Baldur von Schirach: "Führer, ich melde Ihnen Ihre Jugend" (I

present you Your Youth)

Hitler: "Wir brauchen keine Muttersoehnchen, sondern starke Maenner und tapfere Frauen" (We do not want any weaklings, but strong men and brave women.)

1 May 1936

REICHSTAG GIVES HITLER DICTATORIAL POWERS Roll 6 - 4

Goering, Hermann (Adolf Hitler)

Date: 23 March 1933

Scenes in chamber of the Reichstag showing Chancellor Adolf Hitler making a strong declaration on Germany's economic future, etc. Seated in the rear of Hitler is Hermann Goering, both of whom wear Nazi uniform. This picture is historical as it was here that the legal right of Hitlerism was begun (the Reichstag having conferred powers of dictator which Hitler demanded).

23 March 1933

Roll 7-3 HINDENBURG GETS NAMESAKE PLANE

Goering, Hermann (Von Hindenburg)

Date: May 1933

Fox Movietone News

Aged President of Germany attends Berlin christening led by Hermann Goering. Huge plane is unveiled. Goering makes a vehement speech and strikes plane with a bottle. Von Hindenburg in formal civilian attire stands before other group of personalities which include Von Papen, Hitler, Neurath and Blomberg.

May 1933

CONDOR LEGION FROM SPAIN PARADES IN BERLIN Roll 7-4

Goering, Hermann (Condor Legion from Spain)

Date: 6 June 1939

Arrival of Hitler at grandstand. General Richthofen, leader of the Legion Condor, leads parade followed by legionnaires bearing the standard presented by Franco. Troops and Marines follow. Massed troops hear Goering speak. Hitler greeted the legion with cheer and the legion answers. Homage to legionnaires who lost their lives in Spain. General Keitel and Grand Admiral Raeder present.

6 June 1939

GAL THREE

E ATOIN SH ETAOIN SHRDLU CMF

Roll 8 - 1 PRINCE PAUL OF YUGOSLAVIA

Goering, Hermann (Paul of Yugoslavia)

Date: 1 June 1939

Hitler, Ribbentrop, Goering and Mrs. Goering welcome Prince Paul and Princess Olga. Review honor formation. Ride to Bellevue Castle. Later drive to Chancellery for official visit. Drive down Wilhelmstr. and crowds cheer. Dr. Messner and Ribbentrop receive them at entrance of Chancellery. Hitler, Paul, Ribbentrop and Messner on steps of Chancellery. Huge Military Aircraft formations are to be seen during the reception.

1 June 1939

Roll 8-2 HITLER RETURNS FROM VIENNA

Goering, Hermann (Hitler returns from Vienna)

Date: 15 March 1938

Prime Minister *Goering* and Cabinet meet plane at Templehof Airport. Führer greets entire cabinet. Thousands line streets through which Hitler drove to the Chancellery. Thousands packed the Wilhelmstrasse as *Goering* and *Hitler* appear on the balcony. Man in SA uniform next to Hitler may be *Seyss-Inquart*.

15 March 1938

Roll 9-1 ADOLF HITLER'S 49TH BIRTHDAY

Goering, Hermann (Hitler's 49th birthday)

Date: 20 April 1938

Traditional serenade accorded *Hitler* on the morning of the 49th birthday. At noon a big parade took place on Unter den Linden. Divisions of the Navy and Air Forces passed in review. *Goering*, Col. Gen. *Keitel* and Adm. *Raeder* stood beside Hitler on the grandstand. Diplomatic corps was seated on the opposite grandstand. Hitler with *Burman* (?) and *Bouhler* (?). 10 generals and 3 admirals are to be seen at the parade.

20 April 1938

Roll 9-4 FIRST GERMAN AIRCRAFT CARRIER LAUNCHED

Goering, Hermann (aircraft carrier launched)

Date: 8 December 1938

"Graf Zeppelin" German aircraft carrier launched in Adolf Hitler's shipyards of the Deutsche Werke. *Hitler, Goering,* Countess Zeppelin-Breitenstein who christened the ship, Adm. *Raeder* and General *Milch* attended. In his christening speech, Goering said: "By order of the Führer I christen you 'Graf Zeppelin.' You shall become a symbol and factor of the might and power of the German Reich (*Mehrer der Macht und des Ansehens des Reiches*)."

8 December 1938

Roll 10 - 1 NEW YEAR'S RECEPTION 1939

Goering, Hermann (New Year's reception)

Date: 12 January 1939

Arrival of *Goering*, several ambassadors, among them *Orsenigo*. Inside Apostolico Nuncio delivers his speech to Hitler. Hitler receives diplomats and walks through the new court of honor where he receives the Nazi ministers in uniform, among them *Frick* and *Ribbentrop*. *Hitler* and *Meissner* are leaving the Hall.

12 January 1939

Roll 10 - 2 FOUR POWER CONFERENCE AT MUNICH—CZECH PROBLEM

Goering, Hermann (4 power conference at Munich)

Date: 29 September 1938

Goering rubs hands. Hitler meets Mussolini. Drive through cheering crowds. Daladier arrives by plane. "Marseillais" played, met by Ribbentrop and Dr. Fiehler. Crowds cheering. Chamberlain met by Ribbentrop at airport. Shouting crowds through streets. Nazi bedecked bldgs. at airport. In Hitler's house (interior) Hitler, Duce Chamebrlain and Daladier study maps and decide on plans. Goering is in group. Rubs hands greedily. Count Ciano also in group. All sign agreements. Arrival at the conference at different times of notables. Leaving the conference for lunch.

29 September 1938

Gal FOUR

Roll 11 - 2 REICHSTAG CONVENES

Hitler, Adolf (reply to President Roosevelt's request)

Date: 28 April 1939

Hitler leaves Chancellery and drives to Reichstag. Delivers speech in

Reichstag. This is in reply to President Roosevelt's talk:

HITLER: "Herr Roosevelt will nun endlich die Bereitwilligkeit haben, von uns die Zusicherung zu fordern, dass die Deutschen Streitkraefte das Staatsgebiet und die Besitzungen folgender unabhaeng ger Nationen nicht angreifen und vor allem nicht dort einmarschieren duerfen, und er nennt als dafuer in Frage kommend: Finland, Estland, Littauen, Norwegen, Schweden, Niederlande, Belgien, Irland, Portugal, Spanien, die Schweiz, Liechtenstein, Luxemburg, Polen (frenzied shouting and laughter), Ungarn, Rumaenien, Jugoslavien, Russland, Bulgarien, Turkei, Iraq, Arabien, Syrien, Palestina (great shouting and laughter) Egypten... Meine Antwort: Ich habe mir zunaechst die Muehe genommen von den angefuehrten Staaten festzustellen, erstens ob sie sich bedroht fuehlen, zweitens ob vor allem die Anfrage von Herrn Roosevelt an sie durch eine Anregung Ihrerseits oder wenigstens mit ihrem Einverstaendnis erfolgt sei. Die Antwort war eine durchwegs negative, beziehungsweise ablehnende."

(Upon the request of President Roosevelt to make sure that Germany will not invade the above mentioned countries, I undertook to question all these nations, first whether they felt themselves threatened, second whether this request of President Roosevelt was instigated by themselves, or was made with their consent. Their answer was entirely negative and a complete denial.)

Hitler further stated that the threatened invasion existed only in someone's imagination. The only invaded country is Syria, which is occupied by Democratic States. Hitler announces the cancellation of the Naval Treaty with England (followed by frenzied cheers).

He says: "I rely upon my people and I rely upon . . . (cut).

He concludes: ("Ich will abschliessend hier folgendes erklaeren: Die Deutsche Regierung ist jedem der einzelnen genannten Staaten gegenueber bereit, wenn er es wuenschen sollte, unter der Bedingung der Gegenseitigkeit die gewuenschte Erklaerung abzugeben, weil wir nicht nur mit ihnen befreundet sind, sondern sogar Abmachungen haben. Ich will aber nicht die Gelegenheit vorueber gehen lassen um den President der Nord Amerikanishen Union die Versicherung abzugeben, die für sein Gebiet in erster Linie in Frage kommt: ich erklaere feierlich dass ich nicht die Absicht habe die USA anzugreifen" (frenzied cheers and laughter).

(Concluding, I wish to state that Germany is ready to give the requested assurance to all the above mentioned states, under the condition of reciprocity, because we are on friendly terms with all of them, and even have made treaties with them. Voluntarily I wish to give the President of the United States the assurance that I have no intention of attacking the United States) . . .

28 April 1938

Roll 16-3 HITLER AS COMMANDER IN CHIEF PRESENT AT ARMY MANEUVERS NEAR CELLE

Hitler, Adolf (Wehrmacht maneuvers)

Motorized troops, autotank, heavy artillery.

Commander in Chief of the Army, Adolf *Hitler*, Reich War Minister Col. Gen. von Blomberg and General of the Artillery von Fritsch were present—motorized troops, heavy armored cars, autotank cars, infantry in position firing, machine guns, heavy artillery being positioned. Parade before Hitler; von Blomberg and von Fritsch stand beside Der Führer in the grandstand.

4-5 September 1935

Roll 17 - 3 HITLER ON ELECTION CAMPAIGN IN ESSEN

Hitler, Adolf

Date: 28 May 1936

Hitler speaks in Essen in the machine halls of the Krupp Steel Corp.

28 May 1936

GALLEY FIVE

Roll 18 - 1 HITLER AT PARTY DAY 1935

Hitler, Adolf (Party Day, Nuremberg)

Date: 9 September 1935

Hitler driving through city. In front of Hotel troops pass in reveiw. Hitler appears at window. Heads of party and government and representatives of army and navy are present in historical town hall. Lord Mayor *Liebel* welcomes guests, presents Hitler with sword, thus placing Der Führer above the state.

Minister of Foreign Affairs von Neurath and Mrs. Neurath. Representative of the Führer Rudolph Hess, Minister of Interior Affairs Dr. Frick, Reichspropaganda Minister Dr. Goebbels and Mrs. Goebbels.

Von Neurath states: I am convinced that the German people will vote for the Führer and for Germany unanimously. (Ich bin überzeugt dass das Deutsche Volk mit einem 100% igen "Ja" für den Führer und für Deutschland eintreten wird.)

Date: 15 March 1938

Adolf Hitler drives to the Hofburg. On March 16, Vienna celebrated the "Anschluss"—Austria and Germany were united. For hours masses had Been streaming to the "Heldenplatz" (Hero Square). Soon a quarter of a million people were massed in front of the Hofburg, Vienna's Royal Residence. At 11:00 a.m. the Führer drove to the Hofburg and addressed the people of Austria from the balcony of the residence. In his proclamation he made the following statement: "As Führer and Chancellor of the German nation, I declare my country united with the German Reich."

(speaker on the platform of the Nuremberg Stadium):

"I am opening the Sixth Party Congress at Nuremberg in memory of the late president Generalfeldmarschall Hindenburg, (died 2 August 1934), the first soldier of the great war, and in memory of our fallen heroes . . . I welcome the representatives of foreign nations."

(present are mostly Japanese, South American and Panama envoys). "I welcome especially the representatives of our Armed Forces who are

now for the first time under the command of our Führer."

(among the representatives of the Army to be seen: Von Blomberg (Reich Minister of War), Keitel, v. Brauchitsch, Mackensen, Grand Admiral Raeder, predecessor of Döenitz).

Addressing the Führer, he continues:

"Banners and standards are surrounding you!" (in the picture are to be seen Reichsmarschall Hermann Göring; Gauleiter Julius Streicher, Nuremberg; Press Chief Otto Dietrich, Berlin; Alfred Rosenberg, editor of the Voelkischer Beobachter, central organ of the party; Joachim von Ribbentrop, head of the Foreign Office; Gauleiter Robert Wagner, Karlsruhe).

"You, my Führer, are Germany, your sentence is the sentence of the

German people."

(this refers to the assassination of Captain Röhm, shot by Hitler on 30 June 1934.) Cheers and long applause.

"Gratefully we are vowing to follow our Führer in good and bad days, come what may!" (Cheers and long applause.)

"Due to your guidance Germany shall reach her goal to become the home and center (Heimat) for all the Germans of the world."

(Cheers and long applause.) (Josef Goebbels, Propaganda Minister, and Ribbentrop to be seen in the picture).

Alfred ROSENBERG:

(Party leader, in charge of spiritual training and foreign policy; editor of the Voelkischer Beobachter, central party organ):
"Youth has the duty to finish the job of 1918." (Die Jugend soll das welt-

geschichtliche Werk, das 1918 in München erwachte, forsetzen.)

Otto DIETRICH: (Press Chief of the Reich's Cabinet):

"Truth is the foundation on which the press is based. We expect the foreign press to be true above all."

(with regard to reports on Germany).

Fritz TODT:

(Department of Technology, Chief of the OT-Organization Todt, builder of superhighways (Reichsautobahnen), died in 1942):

Gives statistical data on his work.

Fritz REINHART:

(Banker, formerly with Commerzbank, Berlin; head of the Party Department for Finance and Taxation; Secretary of State in the Ministry of Finance):

Reports on improvements of values, buildings and active markets, also promising prosperity for the future.

Richard W. DARRE:

(Federal Peasant Leader, State Secretary in the Department of Agriculture, wearing the uniform of SS, Élite Guards):

"Farmers' prosperity is the foundation for commerce and exports."

GAL. TWO

Julius STREICHER:

(District leader of Franconia, most extreme anti-semite, editor of the ill-famed periodical the Stürmer, wearing SA, Storm Troopers, uniform):

"A nation which does not care for the purity of its race will perish."

Robert LEY:

(Leader of the Labor Front DAF (Deutsche Arbeits-Front), head of the political party organization, editor of the Berlin labor paper Der Angriff, wearing SA uniform):

"I promise to make the German worker proud and upright and to procure him equal rights." (Den Deutschen Arbeiter zu einem stolzen, aufrechten

und gleichberechtigen Genossen zu machen.)

Hans FRANK: (later Governor General of Poland, Reichs-Justiz-Kommissar, president

of the Academy for German Law at Munich):

"Our Commander in Chief is our suppreme judge!" (Der Oberste Führer

ist auch der Oberste Gerichtsherr.)

Konstantin HIERL:

(Leader of the Reich Labor Service RAD (Reichs-Arbeits-Dienst) whose members were later put at the disposal of the supreme command of the

"The German people is prepared for general labor service. We await the

command of our Führer."

Joseph GOEBBELS:

(Minister of Propaganda):

"The flame of our devotion will never die!" (Die helle Flamme unserer

Begeisterung wird nicht erloschen.)

Konstantin HIERL:

(In the picture are to be seen 42,000 members of the newly organized German Labor Service RAD, with new uniforms and their tools, mostly shovels; there are miners, builders, farmers, etc., from all parts of Germany. They are singing): "We are labor—we are soldiers just

the same." (Arbeiter sind wir und trozdem Soldaten.)

Adolf HITLER: (addressing the members of the German Labor Service):

"Manual labor shall not be esteemed inferior to brain work . . . There will be no higher schools in Germany for those who are not trained by our Party." (Niemand wird in Zukunft eine hohe Schule in Deutschland besuchen, der nicht durch unsere Gemeinschaft gegangen ist.)

(Hitler Youth, boys and girls, parading in uniforms, led by Baldur von Schirach. Goebbels, standing next to Hitler, looks at them through field

Baldur von SCHIRACH: (Hitler Youth leader; later federal regent in Vienna):

"Our Führer lives only for us therefore our youth will sacrifice for him . . . You will learn what Germany expects from you." (Ihr sollt in Euch aufnehmen, was wir einst von Euch fur Deutschland hoffen.) "You will harden yourselves like steel when you are young . . . We will show you the way and if we perish you must live to finish our work." (Wir werden Euch vorangehen und wenn wir vergehen, so sollt Ihr leben um unser Werk fortzufuhren.) "You are of the same spirit as we." (In Euren jungen Gehirnen brennt der selbe Geist wie in uns.) (General roll call of the political district leaders of the National Socialist Party NSDAP; torch light procession.)

Victor LUTZE: (Chief of Staff of the SA, died May 1943, succeeded by SA leader Wilhelm Schepmann):

"My Führer, just like in earlier days of the movement, we are awaiting the commands of our Führer and cannot but execute them." (Genau wie in fruheren Tagen der Bewegung werden wir nur auf die Befehle unseres Führers warten und wir konnen nicht anders als die Befehle unseres Führers auszufuhren.)

(Great parade of the Army (Wehrmacht) to be seen are Keitel and Raeder

Great review and display of Army, SA and SS.

Rudolf HESS: "The Sixth Party Congress comes to an end. The Führer has the ear of

Adolf HITLER: (according to National Socialist ideology the unifying link joining State,

Party, Army and People):

"Eternal and indestructible unity between Party and Army shall re-

main the basis of the German Reich."

(In the picture are to be seen most of the leading personalities and

members of the German General Staff.)

Frenzied applause.

"Only the best National Socialists are members of the Party. Today we have to select our followers." (Heute müssen wir unsere Mitglieder

sieben.)

(Party membership at the end of 1934 was about 2,400,000 and remained about that figure until 1 May 1937 when it rose sharply

as the requirements for joining were made less strict.

Among the celebrities who joined the Party at that early date are to be seen in the first row the former president of the German Reichsbank, Dr. Hjalmar *Schacht*, with the Party medal in his button hole.)

"The future is ours. Victory and salute to all persons of German blood."
