This list, compiled away from books and at short notice, is certainly not a complete one. It may also include one or two people who have died or who do not qualify on other grounds. The first four groups are respectively, OKW, Army, Navy and Air Staff Officers at the centre. Group 5 consists of Wehrmacht-befehlshaber, i.e. theatre commanders appointed by OKW with jurisdiction over all arms of the fighting forces. Group 6 is Army Group Commanders. One or two from the Russian front have probably been forgotten. Group 7 consists of Air Force Commanders-in-chief immediately subordinate to the Staff in Berlin. Again there may be one or two omissions. Group 8 lists some Army commanders. Clearly this Group is very much bigger, but I cannot offhand give a full list of the several dozen officers who commanded armies between 1938 and 1945. In addition there are a few Naval officers and a number of Army officers who held static military commands in occupied countries.

Full lists are being prepared.

In 1933 von Blomberg as Reich Defence Minister

(Reichswehrminister) had under him a Chief of Army Staff and
a Chief of Naval Staff (Chef Heeresleitung, Chef Marineleitung).
von Fritsch and Raeder respectively.

In May 1935 von Blomberg became Reich Minister for War and C-in-C Armed Forces (Reichskriegsminister und Oberbefehls= haber der Wehrmacht). The Army and Navy Staffs became High Commands (Oberkommando des Heeres - OKH - and Oberkommando der Kriegsmarine - OKM), their Chiefs being upgraded to Commanders in Chief (Oberbefehlshaber). Von Fritsch and Raeder remained in their positions.

The Air Ministry (Reichsministerium der Luftfahrt) was a separate institution. Göring was at once Air Minister and Commander in Chief of the Air Force (Reichsminister der Luftfahrt und Oberbefehlshaber der Luftwaffe. R.d.L. u. Ob.d.L.) It was not till 1944 that the Air set-up was nominally brought into line with the other services and renamed High Command of the Air Force (Oberkommando der Luftwaffe - OKL).

In both the Reichswehrministerium and Reichskriegsminist=
erium there was an interservice department called the
Wehrmacht. From this developed in February 1938 the High
Command of the Armed Forces (Oberkommando der Wehrmacht - OKW),
which superseded the War Ministry. Keitel became Chief of the
OKW (Chef OKW) and von Blomberg retired. The OKW contained an
Operations Dept. (Wehrmachtführungsamt) - later Operations
Staff (Wehrmachtführungsstab) whose Chief (Chef OKW WFSt) was
Jodl. Warlimont got the title of Deputy Chief in 1941.

Von Brauchitsch replaced von Fritsch in Feb. 1938 as Commander in Chief of the Army and was in turn replaced by Hitler in Dec. 1941. Dönitz succeeded Raeder as Commander in Chief of the Navy in Jan.1943. For the last month of the war von Greim was Commander in Chief of the Air Force in the place of Göring.
