Dr. Rascher, about 40 years old, physician and captain of the Air Corps was ordered, especially by Himmler, to carry out serial- and freezing experiments on prisoners.

of Neufreimenn near Munich. Latter told him that he was afraid terny to be liquidated because Himmler would not allow him to discontinue those experiments. that is the experiment of tearing out glegs, the experiments of aerial presure etc. I asked him "What tearing out of legs?" I have not heard of those experiments "as yet". "Certsinly," he declared, "There is a mechanism to tear out the leg. With these experiments they try out that Styptic."

Later on I asked Kohlenklau if that was true, and he confirmed this statement. He said Rascher once told him : "This one or that one, once sentenced to death and used for that experiment,

endured it and thereby remained alive.

According to K's information they never used for those experiments any persons sentenced to death, but prisoners only, at first Polish priests, later on German clergymen as well.

According to R's information Halder told him that Hitler was the bloodthirstiest man he had ever seen. According to Halder Himmler was ruined first by Heydrich then by Bormann and later on by Hitler.
