Interrogation of ... STROELIN

Stroelin was interrogated briefly to determine the facts with regard to an alleged meeting between Glaise-Horstenau, Gauleiter Bürckel and Stroelin in Stuttgart at the time of the Schuschnigg speech on March 9th in Innsbruck. He states that no meeting of this kind took place to the best of his recollection, although he saw both of these persons in Stuttgart at about this time. He states that he and Glaise-Horstenau spent some time together after the speech made by Glaise-Horstenau to the DAI Congress, but that this was in the company of other persons and that there was no discussion of the existing situation in Austria and in particular nothing was said about the holding of a plebiscite in Austria. He mentioned that at a subsequent meeting with Glaise-Horstenau the latter told him that he had been called to Berlin immediately after the meeting at Stuttgart.
