## AGGRESSIVE WARS

Keitel identifies document No. 442-PS, Order No. 16, concerning invasion of England. He acknowledges his own and Jodl's signature. Keitel was present when the Fuchrer signed it (p. 1-2).

Keitel identifies document No. 443-PS, Order No. 17, concerning air and naval warfare against England (p.2).

Keitel identifies document No. 444-PS, Order No. 18, concerning France, the Iberian Peninsula, Atlantic Islands, Egypt, the

Balkans and Russia, We identifies the document as a true mhotostatic copy which was signed by wither. We acknowledges that he read the document and that he remembers the contents there of (n.2-3).

Reitel identifies document No. 445-PS, Order No. 19, concerning the occupation of Vichy France and the capture of the French fleet and air force. He stated that the document was signed by Jodl and initialed by himself. He remembers the contents of the document (p.3-4).

Keitel identifies document No. 446-PS, Order No. 21, concerning the invasion of Russia. He stated that it was signed by Hitler and initialed by himself ("K"), by Jodl ("J"), by Warlimont ("""), and Mayor Von Lossberg ("VLG"). The last-named wrote the document. The word "Barbarossa" is a code name for preparation for invasion of Russia (p.4,8).

Keitel identifies document No. 447-PS. This was a supplemental order based on document No. 446-PS, or Order No. 21. The writer of the document was May. Von Lossberg who initialed it with the letters "VLG". Gen. Parliment and Jodl probably directed Von Lossberg to prepare it. Since the Fuchrer insisted Meitel had to sign this document. We initialed it before the Fuchrer put his signature on it (p.5-7).

Keitel acknowledges document No. 448-PS, Order No. 22, concerning operations in Africa and Albania. It was signed by Keitel, Jodl and Hitler (p.8).

Keitel identifies document No. 449-PS, Order No. 23, concerning the warfare against British war economy. He recognizes the signature of Hitler and Adjudant Christian, and the initials of Jodl (n.9-10).

Moitel identifies document No. 450-PS, Order No. 28, concerning the occupation of Crete. It is signed by Wither and certified to by Captain Boes (p.10).
