KEITEL recognized WARLIMONT'S initials on Document 884-PS, which concerned the treatment of captured Russian political representatives. He stated, however, that he had no knowledge of the meeting of 16 July 1941 between representatives of the OKW and of the police (Document 502-PS), the meeting at which SCHEILENBURG and HEYDRICH represented the police and as a result of which directions to police commandos were drawn up. He further stated that he did not believe that General REINECKE attended any such meeting and that if he were today asked to designate a representative at such a meeting, it would be Admiral CANARIS and not General REINECKE.

HINKEL
