SUBJECT: Emergency Call for Dr. Robert Ley, Prisoner in the Criminal Wing.

TO: Colonel B. C. Andrus, Commandant, 6850TH Internal Security
Detachment, International Military Tribunal, APO 403, US Army.

At 2015 hours 25 October 1945 an emergency call from the Court Jail reached this officer at his quarters for his immediate need at the jail. Major Teich, Lt. Durkee, and Lt Colonel Juchli, MC, drove at once to the jail, arriving at 2027 hours.

At double quick time all three officers entered the cell of LEY who was on his cot, apparently lifeless, with the German Dentist administering artificial respiration. After about 20 minutes of induced respirations, the prisoner was carefully examined and pronounced deat by strangulation at 2035 hours.

The body was at once transferred to the morgue of the 116th General Hospital where it was autopsied. On the 26 October 1945 the body was interned in the South Side Municipal Cemetery at Nurnberg, Germany in an unmarked grave, with the approval of the Ober-Burgermeister consulted by this officer at the provisional Ratheshaus at Billing Strasse.
