## Letter from Hitler to Franco - September 1940

- 1. War will decide future of Europe. Spain can help put England out of the Mediterranean.
- 2. Spanish participation must begin with expulsion of British from Gibraltar. Capture of the Rock itself. Germany will furnish assault troops and weapons under Spanish command.
- 3. With this done, Spanish Mediterranean coast no longer threatened.
- 4. England in position to operate against Spanish coast. Defense of coast difficult. Better to protect it by dive bombers than by heavy coastal batteries.
- 5. The entry of Spain will serve to stress the hopelessness of carrying out the war and force England to abandon her unjustifiable ambitions.
