Witness protested against certain incidents at Dachau, and against the concentration camp system in general (4-6). Witness admits that this system, as well as other measures, were part of a plan by an inner circle to take over the government (7-8). Hitler's principal advisers were Himmler, Goering, Goebbels, Borman, Streicher, Frick, Ribbentrop, Heydrich (11-12; 18). Witness always tried to make the German laws more legal (12-14). Discussion of illegality of concentration camps, and legality of Hitler's becoming chancellor (14-18).
