SUBJECT: Publicity for the Execution of Spies and Saboteurs.

TO : Commanding General, First U. S. Army Group, APO 655

- 1. It has been decided that the maximum publicity is to be given to executions of spies and saboteurs in the theater of operations, subject to the following provisions:
- a. That the executions in question are carried out under the authority of the indigenous administration.
- b. That publicity should emanate, or appear to emanate, from the indigenous administration.
- c. That publicity has in every case received the prior approval of Counter-Intelligence Staffs.
- 2. You are directed to take all necessary action to insure that this decision is fully implemented by all the means at your disposal.
