Werner von Blowland first Clief of the Office of troops in the Reichswar Minister, then Suprame Commander in East Prussia commanding helse. Inf.Div. Since fall of 1931 head of the military delegation to the dinarmament conference in Geneva (p.2). From 30th Jan. 1933 till 25-26-27- Jan 1938, Minister for War, and the Supreme Commander of the German Armed Forces. Exiled from that date for a year than returned to Germany to live, received a call order from the Justice that he was to retire completely from public life, and not to have any official connections with either the Government of the army (p.1). The external reason for his diministral was a manufage to his secretary, he was the real cause was that Hitler and the Party desired to governe of him (Blomberg) and Colonel General Fritsch (p.2).

To his knowledge, Moszbach as the last adjudant of the Fuehrer. His task was to keep Midison with army, and at the same time was chief adjutant of the Fuehrer (p.3). When asked whether he recalled a conference in Berlin on Nov. 10, 1937. (Hoszbach minutes quoted and referred to on page 6-21) at which Hitler made a speech about expansion of his foreign policy, he stated that he could not precisely remember the people present, or remember the content of this meeting due to the frequency of such meetings at which the Fuehrer gave his fantasy free play (p.4). After hiving Hoszbach minutes is referred to on page 6-21 von Blomberg stated now that the contents were repeated to him, he remembere the occurrence of the mating. (p.31)
