

TO: General Donovan

The assertions of Mrs. Struenck are correct. The husband of Mrs. Struenck, Captain Dr. Theodor Struenck, was hanged in Flossenbuerg on the 9th of April, 1945, together with Admiral Canaris, General Oster, Captain Gehre, Pastor Dietrich Bonhoeffer by the SS. Only against Struenck there was a judgement of the people's court. Struenck was condemned to death. In many cases only Kaltenbrunner himself would know whether people under arrest were actually executed.

I propose to ask Kaltenbrunner if he is guilty of the execution of many Germans as Struenck, von Dohnanyi, Canaris, Oster, Bonhoeffer.
