SUBJECT : Possible Use of General THOMAS as Witness

We have discussed this matter with General Donovan, who had also requested that THOMAS be questioned at Falkenstein. In view of the fact that approval has been given for the interrogation by General Donovan of THOMAS in the hospital at Falkenstein, it is suggested that you prepare a list of questions and make them available to General Donovan to be included in the general interrogation; later on a decision can be made as to whether or not THOMAS should be brought to Nurnberg.
