1.) ~~The~~ The witness No 11 Naujocks is accused through General von Falkenhhausen. Naujocks shall be a represent of the 44. He shall have tried to instigate against Falkenhhausen and his chief Colonel von Harbou. Harbou was killed in October 1943. Falkenhhausen was dismissed July 1944.

2) The witness No 23 Bach-Zelewski was Gruppenführer of the 44. He has killed some persons on 30th June 1934. Later he was ahead of the 44 against the Russians and he has made many atrocities.
