Dr. Otto LENZ, Attorney-at-law in Berlin-Charlottenburg, Schlueterstr. 59.

Lenz was formerly in the Reich Ministry of Justice, from which he resigned because he did not wish to be connected with Guertner's policies and because, from the very beginning, he was opposed to the National Socialist regime. He then became a lawyer. He shared his law offices with attorney Dr. Etscheit, who lost his life at Flossenbuerg and who was a friend of General Halder.

Good source of information. Condemned to four years in penitentiary.

Dr. SCHUSTER

Lichtenau near Kassel, Hopfelderstr. 1, care of Sander.

Schuster was with the Reichspostministerium.
Well informed with regard to the internal relationship between political leaders and military authority. He was a confident in official circles (Ministerial). He obtained valuable information via telephone censorship.
