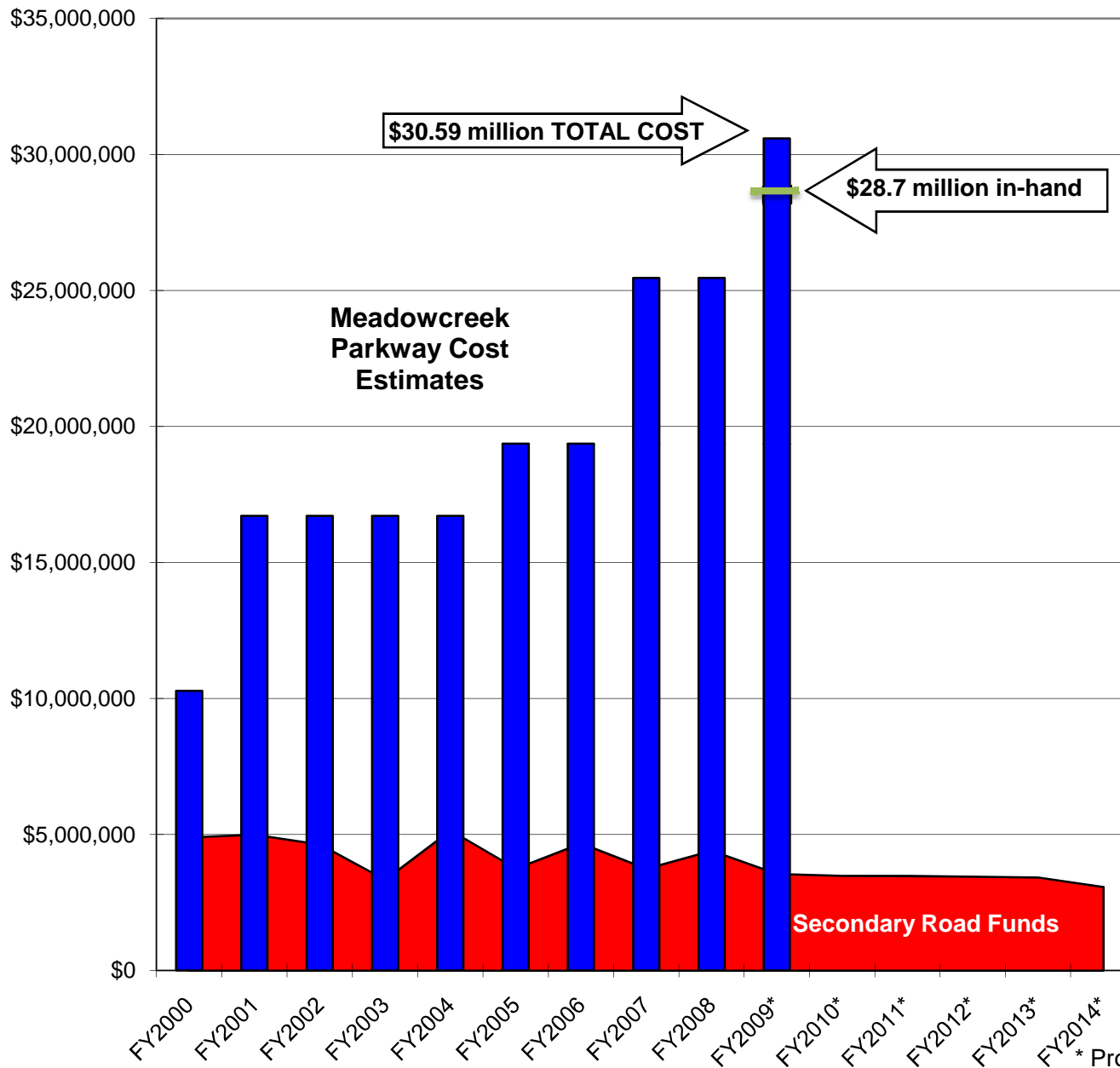




Comparing Albemarle's Secondary Road Funds to Meadowcreek Parkway Costs



In July 2008, the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors will consider a resolution to apply for VDOT Revenue Sharing funds to help cover the \$1.8 million gap between the \$28.7 million allocated for the County's portion of the Meadowcreek Parkway, and the new cost estimate of \$30.6 million. To qualify for \$1 million in new state funding, the County will need to spend \$1.5 million from the Capital Improvement Program. The project is scheduled to be advertised for construction in October, 2008.

Primary vs. Secondary

Do you know the difference between a "primary road" and a "secondary road?" Primary roads are the roads numbered below 600 (e.g. Rt 22, Rt 20, Rt 29, Rt 240, Rt 250). Secondary roads are everything numbered 600 and above (e.g. Meadowcreek Pkwy #631, Jarman's Gap #691).
