

# STUDY OBJECTIVE

*Approved by School Board on June 8, 2017:*

Address current and projected overcrowding at Greer Elementary, Woodbrook Elementary, and Agnor-Hurt Elementary and to consider middle school student assignments based upon changes to elementary boundaries.

The proposed scope of the study will involve any and all elementary and middle schools determined by the committee required to meet this objective. If the committee determines that the redistricting might impact an elementary school not identified above, the committee will notify the Board and that school community.

# GUIDING PRINCIPLES

1. Attendance areas will serve the district for at least 3-5 years with a goal of 5-7 years
2. Attendance areas will be largely contiguous.
3. Walk areas for each school will be considered.
4. When possible, middle school boundaries will align with elementary boundaries.
5. Transportation routes will be as efficient as possible, giving consideration to minimizing ride times within acceptable parameters.
6. Neighborhoods will be assigned to the same school whenever possible.
7. Greater demographic balance amongst impacted schools will be strived for where feasible.
8. Grandfathering existing students will be considered by the Board on a study by study basis.

# ENROLLMENT

- “Frozen Data”: September 6, 2017
  - Exact enrollment changes daily. For analysis purposes, data were frozen to evaluate number of students in particular neighborhoods, demographics, etc.
- September 30<sup>th</sup> Enrollment
  - Key benchmark; data submitted to state
  - Enrollment projections are based on this data set
- Enrollment Projections
  - 10 Year projections are completed annually
  - Utilizes live birth data and a cohort survival method
  - Based on historical trends
  - Future developments influence the model





# CURRENT BOUNDARIES – ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS



















# MIDDLE SCHOOL IMPLICATIONS

- Scenario B3 has no middle school implications. All affected neighborhoods and receiving schools are districted to Jouett
- Scenario A + C
  - Option 1 – No change to middle school boundaries when elementary boundary changes. This creates a split feeder pattern at Woodbrook.
  - Option 2 – Change the middle school boundaries of Agnor-Hurt + Burley to eliminate splits
  - Option 3 - Change middle school boundary if elementary boundary changes to avoid creating new splits.





## Why are other schools not involved in this study?

With the exception of Broadus Wood, surrounding schools do not have sufficient capacity to resolve the overcrowding in the urban ring schools.






**With the updated projections, Agnor-Hurt is not overcrowded. Why are they still included in scenarios?**

- There is significant potential future residential development within the Agnor-Hurt attendance area. These developments are likely to yield additional students that would cause the school to be overcrowded.
- As Agnor-Hurt shares borders with both Greer and Woodbrook, it is important that it be studied as a part of potential solutions to Greer's and Woodbrook's overcrowding.

# Residential Development Pipeline





## **Will Woodbrook be school-wide multiage next year? Will I have an option to opt-out?**

There will be multiple varieties of learning spaces available at Woodbrook. The new additions include spaces similar to the large Agnor-Hurt multiage space, while renovations in the existing building will create both single and double classrooms. There is flexibility in spacing based on student and teacher needs. Woodbrook Elementary School's administrative team will be seeking parent input throughout the transition process to ensure parents, students and teachers are comfortable with the instructional grouping decisions.



**My child will be a fifth grader next year. Will they have the option to stay at their current school?**

A recommendation on a 'grandfather clause' will be made by the committee as a part of their overall recommendation. Options could include rising 5<sup>th</sup> graders, rising 5<sup>th</sup> graders + siblings, or other variations. It could also include no clause at all. Ultimately, the decision is up to the School Board. Please note that transportation is not provided to grandfathered students.
