The Dr. Robert Stanger Young Artists Concerto Audition for the 2017-18 season will be conducted by the Kiwanis Club of Elmhurst and the Elmhurst Symphony Association in cooperation with the former Auxiliary of the Elmhurst Symphony Association through its Eunice B. Sidener Scholarship on February 17, 2018, at Elmhurst Christian Reformed Church, 149 W. Brush Hill Rd. in Elmhurst. The yearly Stanger Audition provides an opportunity for outstanding high school orchestral instrumentalists and pianists to grow as musicians, gain recognition for their efforts preparing for the Audition, and compete for the opportunity to perform a concerto movement with the Elmhurst Symphony Orchestra.
