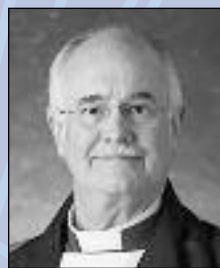

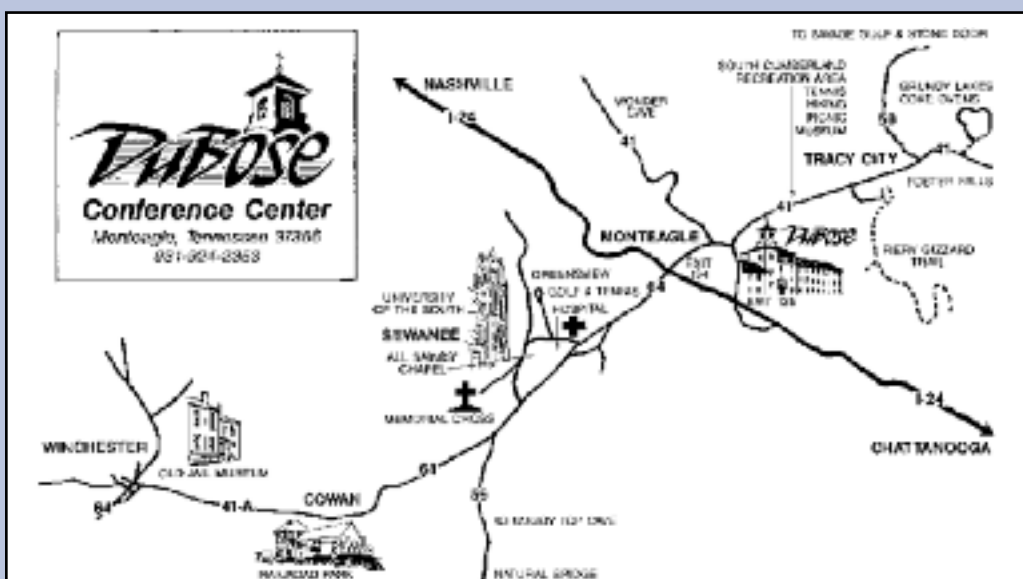
### Classes, Workshops, Lectures

The 2010 sessions include Hymn Playing, Organ Repertoire, Singing the Psalms, Composing for the 21st Century Church, Episcopal Basics (materials and methods for planning liturgies and music—especially useful for those who may be new to the Episcopal Church), "Does your Priest Sing?", "Fixing your Choir," and four lectures given by the Bishop of Nebraska, the Right Reverend Joe Burnett.

## LOCATION, HOUSING AND FEES

The Sewanee Church Music Conference is headquartered at the DuBose Conference Center in Monteagle, Tennessee, situated at an altitude of 2,000 feet and located five miles from The University of the South, off Interstate 24 between Chattanooga and Nashville. Conference activities are held at both DuBose and the University.



Housing is available at the DuBose Conference Center in either of two buildings, Bishops Hall and Claiborne Hall. Bishops Hall is air-conditioned with ensuite bathrooms; doubles only, no elevators. Claiborne Hall has shared bathrooms and ceiling fans (no air-conditioning); mostly double rooms with a few singles available, no elevators. All reservations are booked "first come, first served" and no accommodations for pets, children, or non-registered persons are possible. Absolutely NO SMOKING is permitted in any of the buildings. Off campus housing is available at several sites (you are responsible for making your own arrangements) and a list can be obtained from the Registrar.

For those flying to the conference, transportation can be arranged with shuttle services from the Nashville or Chattanooga airports (Nashville is usually the better choice). Remember that Chattanooga is on Eastern Time and Nashville and Sewanee are on Central Time. Allow two hours for travel between Nashville and the conference center and an hour for Chattanooga. Express Shuttle: 800.896.9928.

The 2010 registration fee of \$250 covers all costs associated with administering the conference with the exception of room and board. It also includes the packet of music with repertoire to be sung during the Evensong and Sunday morning's Eucharist. An acknowledgement of your registration will be sent. Credit cards are **NOT** accepted.

### Worship

The Sewanee Conference provides opportunities for daily worship in the DuBose Chapel. There will also be Choral Evensong sung by the Sewanee Church Music Conference Choir on Friday night, and the closing Festival Eucharist on Sunday morning. Both of these services will be held in the gothic splendor of All Saints' Chapel on the campus of The University of the South.

### Reading Sessions

Malcolm Archer will conduct a reading session of his anthems and Dr. Mark Schweizer will present materials published by the St. James Music Press. Dr. Marty Burnett and Dr. Bradley Almquist will also conduct reading sessions, and Dr. Robert Delcamp and Keith Shafer will present a session on organ repertoire.

### Concert and Silent Film

On Tuesday night the Grand Court Organist of the Wanamaker Organ in Philadelphia, Peter Richard Conte, will give a concert on the Casavant pipe organ in All Saints' Chapel on the Sewanee campus. The program will include a silent film with improvised accompaniment.

### Social Events

The 2010 Sewanee Conference includes numerous social events, including an opening Reception in the DuBose Pavilion, a Dessert Reception following Tuesday night's organ recital, the Banquet served in Cravens Hall on the Sewanee Campus, and an old-fashioned southern-style Picnic in the Pavilion on Saturday night. Following the picnic the conference will enjoy the annual "Frolic," a show featuring skits and comedy routines performed by conferees.

### Commissioned Music

The 2010 Conference has commissioned Malcolm Archer to write an anthem that will be premiered during the conference.
