Participants at the Youth & Adult Choir Conferences will present music rehearsed during the weekend at the Eucharist on Sunday at St. Francis by the Sea Episcopal Church. The Rt. Rev'd Clifton Daniel, 3rd (Diocese of East Carolina) will preside. Family members are invited to join us for this liturgy. St. Francis by the Sea is approximately one mile south of Trinity Center.

Other things you might like to know

This camp is designed for rising 4th-9th graders. The choristers will stay in dorms and need to bring linens, swimsuits, towels, snacks, and if they wish, musical instruments. Youth Camp Supervisors are present at all times and at least two adult advisors will be housed in each dorm. Free time will be supervised for safety reasons and Trinity Center has a Health Center. Please remember to complete and sign the Medical Release Form and return it with your registration. Counselors in Training must be in, at least, the 11th grade and pay the full registration fee. Four CITs will be chosen, two of whom must be male.
