Position Detail: Service Music. Working in close cooperation with the rector and other clergy of the parish, the Minister of Music is responsible for:

- Selecting appropriate hymns, anthems and other music for Sunday services each week
- Hiring professional musicians for Christmas, Easter, and other special services
- Ensuring that service music is consistent with the theme of the scripture readings, the sermon and the overall tone of the services
