

## PILGRIMAGE HIGHLIGHTS

- -Stay 3 nights in Nazareth, home of Mary, Joseph and Jesus. Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and explore excavations of the ancient city under our Guest House. Worship with local Anglican parish.
- -Take a gentle boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, visit Capernaum with the ancient Synagogue, the Church of the Loaves and Fishes and the Chapel of St. Peter's Primacy.
- -Float in the Dead Sea and visit Mt. Tabor and the site of the Dead Sea Scrolls in Qumran.
- -Travel to the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem as well as Shepherd's Field.
- -Go to Nablus/Zababdeh, site of Jacob's Well, and hear again the story of Jesus and the Samaritan Woman.

- -Stay 6 nights at St. George's College near Old Jerusalem. It is an easy walk for exploring the various quarters of the walled city.
- -Walk the Palm Sunday Road and end at the Garden of Gethsemane.
- -Pray the Way of the Cross on the Via Dolorosa and worship at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.
- -Visit the Western Wall and add your written prayers to the ancient wall.
- -Learn from guest speakers their perspective of life in the region as a Jew and as a Muslim. Visit with Christians and hear their unique perspectives.
- -Visit St. George's Anglican Cathedral and other diocesan institutions.
- Experience the Night Spectacular at the Tower of David.
