## Welcome to Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Level I!

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a religious education program grounded in scriptural and liturgical study. The Catechesis is based on the principle that the child desires to draw near to God. This relationship between God and the child is assisted by the adult, but directed by the Spirit of God within the child. The adult's task is to prepare the physical and spiritual environments that call forth the child's response. Themes are offered in such a way as to develop the religious potential present in every child: the capacity to love and be loved.

#### This course will include:

- The developmental and religious nature and needs of the 3

   6 year old child.
- Those aspects of God and the kingdom of heaven that most deeply strike the 3-6 year old's sense of wonder and enjoyment of God.
- Helping the young child more fully experience and participate in the liturgical expressions of his/her faith community.
- Demonstration of all materials and presentations used in the three-year program cycle.
- Helping participants develop a personal catechist's album of presentations
- ♦ How to effectively communicate CGS to a community.

This course will cover the entire Level I curriculum. A syllabus will be available for your review. Participants are strongly encouraged to begin the assigned readings prior to each course session.
