## A Dynamic History of Success

### EGR's Accomplishments

#### Growth of a grassroots network that is transforming the church for mission

- 130+ diocesan contact people in 75 dioceses
- 5,500 people receiving bi-monthly e-newsletter
- More than 1,500 youth/young adults networked online on Facebook
- Spearheaded "U2charist movement" raising more than \$200,000 for MDGs. More than 250 U2charists held on four continents.
- EGR's website is the primary destination in the church for people looking for MDG resources.

#### Focal events for a grassroots movement

- Give it 4 Good "stimulus check" campaign that provided resources for a Christian examination of consumerism/consumption & raised more than \$100,000 for MDG-related ministries
- Worldwide individual and parish components to Lambeth Walk of Witness and Sept. 25 events .

#### Forging partnerships for creative mission

- Brings together wide variety of groups for creative mission and ministry opportunities.
- Provides keynote speakers, preachers, workshop leaders for diocesan conventions, provincial gatherings, clergy gatherings and more.
- Provides countless hours of personal consulting for individuals and congregations.

#### A Meeting Place for God's Mission

- We're a community where people across the theological/political spectrum of the church come together to work, pray & celebrate God's mission.
- Our board membership, donor list, & friends reflect this diversity. EGR is where the entire Church comes together not in conflict but in Christ-centered mission.
