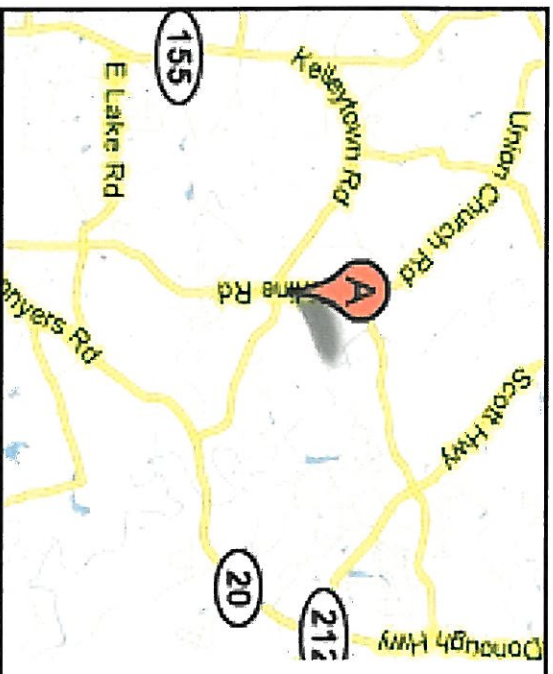

Joan served as moderator of the General Assembly Permanent Judicial Commission and a member of the PCUSA’s Advisory Committee on the Constitution. She has received praise for providing a calming presence for congregations in conflict.
