"Know Your Number" with Suzanne Stabile

The Enneagram is an ancient personality typing system that identifies nine types of people. It is a powerful tool for explaining why persons behave the way they do and how motivation is determined by personality. The wisdom of the Enneagram is universal, deep and life-changing for everyone who is serious about their spiritual journey. Knowledge of the Enneagram creates a desire to interrelate rather than isolate and how to celebrate diversity both individually and denominationally.

Suzanne Stabile is the co-founder of Life in the Trinity Ministry, Dallas TX. She is an Enneagram Master whose wisdom about this tool makes her seminars widely attended. She introduces us to the nine types.
