



What is Peace Partners?

Peace Partners is a Network of Parishes ,Cathedrals and individuals linked through Episcopal Peace Fellowship. It is a way to support Peace and Justice ministries of each parish and to support EPF.

Why should a Parish or Cathedral Join Peace Partners?

Peace Partners is a way to advertise the parish, receive valuable services and support the great work of Episcopal Peace Fellowship. When families and individuals are looking for a new parish, they will be attracted to a parish that identifies themselves as a Peace Parish. As long term EPF member, Ida Mae Patteson (Knoxville, TN) said: “when I went to look for a new parish, I needed to find one that acted out their commitment to Peace, I wanted a parish where we could have an EPF chapter”. Parish priest, Ted Curtis (Chicago, IL) said, “This is great for our parish, it will let folks seeking a peace centered parish know what we do and where we are”.

*Each Peace Parishes will be listed in the EPF **Peace Parish Directory** to be placed on the web site of the National Church, Episcopalians for Global Reconciliation; Episcopal Urban Caucus; and many other Episcopal organizations and diocesan web sites. **The Peace Parish Directory** is a way to advertise the work of the parish:

*Peace Parishes will also receive a decal identifying the parish as a peace parish

*Peace Parishes will be allowed to use the EPF constant contact account to send good looking e-mails to large numbers of folks.

*EPF will communicate regularly with Peace Partner Parishes by sending resources and providing tools that will help Partners in their peace and justice ministries.
