Dear Mr. Brent,

This letter is to inform you that at the April 2016 meeting, the Commission of the Accrediting Council for Continuing Education & Training (ACCET) unanimously voted to debar you for ten years from participation as a future owner or senior administrator of an ACCET accredited institution. This debarment was the result of the Commission's review of the precipitous closure of the Brensten Education main campus in Waukesha, Wisconsin without adequate arrangements for students enrolled at the time of the closure.

Under ACCET policy, outlined in Document 11 – Policies and Practices of the Accrediting Commission (available at www.accet.org), an individual debarred may appeal the Commission's decision. If you wish to appeal the decision, the Commission must be notified in writing no later than fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of the receipt of this letter, and such notification must be accompanied by a non-refundable certified or cashier's check in the amount of \$8,500, payable to ACCET. If a timely appeal is initiated, you must subsequently provide a written brief addressing the grounds for appeal. Failure to appeal or failure to comply with any of the requirements outlined for the appeal process will constitute a final action of debarment, without further administrative notice or recourse.
