Title: Volunteer Outreach Coordinator

The successful candidate will be responsible for recruiting volunteers for ECMA 2018 Halifax, Nova Scotia. The ECMA is supported each year by 400+ volunteers, and the Coordinator will develop a recruitment plan to raise awareness and engage the local community to fulfill a diverse set of roles to help deliver this Festival.

This position reports to the Volunteer Coordinator and requires communication with all staff to ensure an understanding of skills and requirements required for each department & volunteer roles. Diplomacy and patience will be required.

General Tasks

- Develop a recruitment strategy to engage 400+ volunteers for ECMA 2018.
- Raise awareness and engage the community by organizing volunteer rallies, engaging other volunteer organizations and community groups from the Halifax area.
- Work with the Volunteer Coordinator to determine specific areas of volunteer expertise and recruit accordingly.
- Work in the Halifax Event office to manage volunteer general and specific inquiries, including assistance with volunteer database software.
- Support the Halifax Event Office to aid with public inquiries.
- Work closely with Volunteer Coordinator on-site to assist with volunteer training, rescheduling and overall management, as required.
- Work with Volunteer Coordinator to coordinate food and beverage needs for volunteer centre, off-site venues, Volunteer Thank You Party, working within budget and with designated partners.
- Set priorities and able to work independently and as part of a team
- Work in cooperation with other event office staff and event committee members



- Performing other duties as may be required by the ECMA Management team
- Provide input to Volunteer Coordinator regarding observations and recommendations for future ECMA events.
