

"Formula" Grants

Energy Efficiency Block Grants

- > \$14.5 Million
 - > 68% to 10 largest municipalities, direct award
 - > 60% of 32% to rest of municipalities, OER distributes
 - > 40% of 32% to State Energy Programs, OER distributes
- > Acceptable Uses
 - Federal Pretty wide open
 - State Anticipate restrictions



"Formula" Grants

State Energy Programs

- > \$24.5 Million OER distributes
- Acceptable Uses
 - Federal Pretty wide open
 - > State Pretty wide open



Rhode Island Stimulu-mingled s and RGGI Funds

"Formula" Grants

Weatherization Assistance Program

- > \$20.0 Million OER distributes
- Acceptable Use Low-Income Weatherization
- > To be comingled with \$10 million from other sources

Smart Grid

- Oriented toward electric utilities
- ➤ RI working with National Grid Vehicle to Grid pilot



Competitive Grants

Advanced Battery Research

- > Oriented toward battery manufacturers
- > RI working with Lithion



Competitive Grants

Transportation Electrification

- > Oriented toward electric vehicle manufacturers
- > RI working with several companies



Competitive Grants

Alternate Fueled Vehicles

> RI working with several electric vehicle companies



Competitive Grants

Energy Star Appliances

- > Oriented toward electric utilities
- > National Grid making application



Competitive Grants

Technology Commercialization

> Waiting for DOE guidance



RGGI Funds

- > Three auctions held to date
- Approximately \$3 million total proceeds
- Public hearing today on spending plan
- > Draft plan:
 - Proceeds to National Grid
 - > 60% to defray SBC increase from least-cost-procurement
 - > 40% for innovative programs
