## Syrah

#### The 2010 Vintage

2010 can be summed up with one word: cool. Very similar to 1999 a late bud break was followed a very cool summer. Warmer weather finally began in August and early September. Picking dates were up to two weeks later than the previous year. Rain presented challenges in late September and then again throughout October. Winemakers and vineyard managers had to decide whether they should pick early and try and limit rot damage or roll the dice, add hang time and sugar, and hope to avoid significant loss due to rot. The wines produced are a combination of beautiful aromatics, profound elegance and wonderful balance.

#### Winemakers Notes

This wine is from another of the great vineyards in Washington State: Red Willow. Located south of Yakima, Red Willow is owned and operated by the Sauer family. The wine was fermented using commercial yeast designed specifically for Syrah and was fermented for 18 days then gently pressed. Free run and press fraction juice were separated and pumped into French Burgundy barrels, 33% of which were new. Malolactic fermentation was completed in barrel. This wine was racked only once prior to bottling.

#### **Tasting Notes**

Roasted marrowbones, cured meat, black olive, minerals and cracked black pepper are wrapped in layers of violets, wet tobacco and warm soil. The small fraction of oak gives hints of vanilla and mocha. The palate is lush with fine tannins and a velvet finish.
