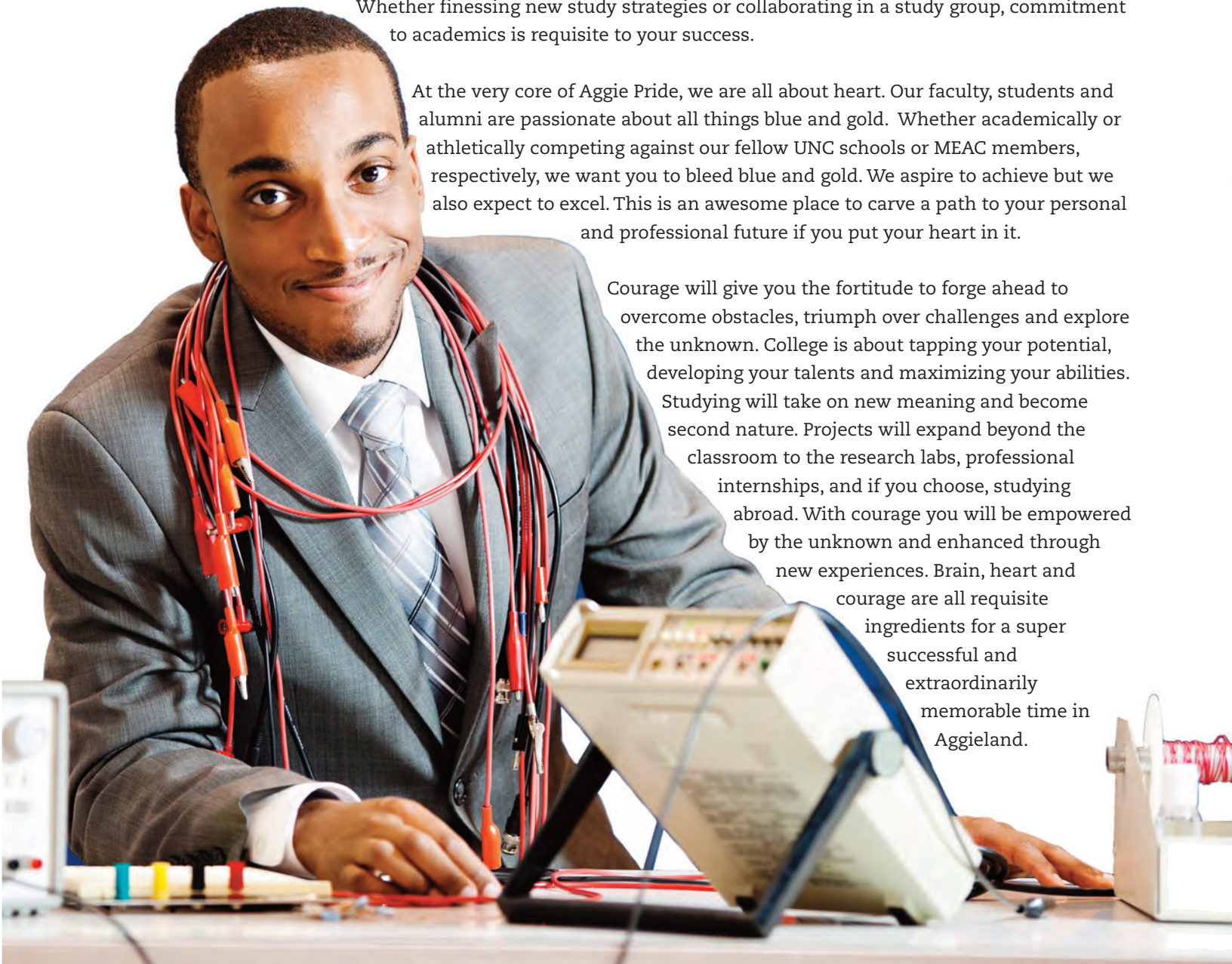
BRAINS, HEART & COURAGE

Official Transcripts:

New Student Registration Fees

Freshman - \$175.00

Transfer/Non-Traditional Student - \$100.00

The **NON-REFUNDABLE** New Student Orientation fee will be applied to the student's Fall 2013 tuition bill. NO payment is due at Orientation registration.

New Freshman Guest Fees

Age 13+: \$80 per person

Age 6-12: \$25.00 per person

Transfer/Non-Traditional Student Parent/Guest Fees

Age 13+: \$50 per person

Age 6-12: \$15.00 per person

The **NON-REFUNDABLE** guest fee is due at the time of completing the orientation registration form. However, payments are accepted on-site.

FINANCIAL AID

You must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to be considered for financial aid. Financial aid is available on both a need and non need-basis. A student is offered a combination of aid (known as a financial aid award package) from one or more of the following types of financial aid options:

- ▣ Federal or State Grants
- ▣ Student Loans
- ▣ Scholarships
- ▣ Federal Work-Study

To be eligible to receive financial aid assistance, the applicant must:

- ▣ Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- ▣ Be admitted and currently enrolled at least half time as an undergraduate or graduate student
- ▣ Be enrolled in a degree program at NC A&T State University
- ▣ Be a US citizen, permanent resident or eligible international student
- ▣ Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) toward the completion of a degree program
- ▣ Must not be in default on any prior federal student loans
- ▣ Must not owe a repayment on any Title IV financial aid
- ▣ Cannot have been convicted as an adult of possessing or selling illegal drugs
