PURPOSE

Walk to Emmaus

To renew the church as a body of the risen Christ in the world through the renewal of Christians as faithful and committed disciples of Jesus Christ.

Chrysalis

To give young people ongoing support on their faith journey in a community of their peers and adults, and to empower them to continue their own



PURPOSE

Face to Face

To resource a group within the Christian community to provide leadership for a spiritual formation experience for individual 60 years and older.

Journey to the Table

To empower young adults, often 18 to 35 years old, to search well in this time of their journey of faith with much transition, to share models of what faith-based conversation can look like and to try a variety of spiritual practices.

night before


Movie optional with Board approval


Minimum of 12 caterpillars

EVENT

Face to Face

- Co-ed with single gender table communities
- 14 Talks – 8 laity, 5 clergy, 1 can be either laity or clergy
- Eight (8) schedule blocks, in 4, 6, or 8 day formats
- Protected, cloistered environment
- Sponsor's Hour
- All talks are previewed by conference room team
- Dying Moments
- Candlelight
- Personal agape
- Closing
- Minimum of 20 pilgrims



EVENT


Journey to the Table

- A consistent learning rhythm
- Seven (7) Schedule Blocks
- Clergy-Laity partnership
- Experiencing Holy Communion together
- Peer Leadership

- Involvement and engagement in journey of spiritual formation






Our Mission
