

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ELIGIBILITY & TEAM FORMATION

Who is eligible to join Enactus Races?

Races are team competitions open to all registered students on Enactus teams. Please visit enactus.org/where-we-work/ to see the 36 countries where Enactus currently operates. Not part of Enactus? Contact international@enactus.org to learn how you can join.

Can my Enactus team participate in a particular Race with more than one project?

Yes. Enactus teams are welcome form more than one project team to submit multiple projects to a particular Race.

Can Enactus students from different Enactus teams form a project team?

While we encourage you to connect and collaborate with other Enactus teams while participating in Races, only Enactus students and Faculty Advisors from the same Enactus team can form a project team.

Does my Enactus team have to compete at my country's Regional or National Competition/Exposition to participate in a Race?

To be eligible to advance to the Impact Competition of a particular Race, the Enactus team must compete at their country's 2018 Regional or National Competition.

- If your Enactus country has Regional Competitions, you must compete at a Regional Competition. >Your team does not have to advance to the National Competition to be eligible for a Race's Impact Competition.
- If your Enactus country has a National Competition only, you must compete at the National Competition.
- Race teams that do not compete in their country's competition process are not eligible to compete in a Race's Impact Competition.
- Enactus reserves the right to grant exceptions to teams for extenuating circumstances that prevent a team from competing in their country's competition process. Teams seeking an exception due to extenuating circumstances must put their request in writing via email no later than 1 June 2018. Enactus will review exception requests. Decisions by Enactus are final. See the Race's Impact Competition Guide and Tips for details.

Note: teams who do not compete in their country's 2018 Regional or National Competition may still participate in the Action and Progress phases of the Races. To be eligible for Progress Rewards, teams must compete in their country's 2018 Regional or National Competition.

Does my Race team have to submit a 77-second video to participate in a Race?

In order to be eligible for Progress Rewards of a particular Race, a team must submit a 77-second video no later than 1 June 2018 by 17:00 GMT Read the [77-Second Video Guidelines](#) for more information.

THE WORLD WATER RACE

What kinds of measurable results are you looking for?

We want to know how your project is delivering measurable progress towards addressing water and/or sanitation challenges. In your Progress Report, we'll ask you to provide data on the following success metrics. Note: some success metrics may not be applicable to your project. We encourage teams to report additional success metrics that are relevant to their particular efforts.

- Number of people directly impacted
- Number of people indirectly impacted
- Number of people with new/improved access to safe and affordable drinking water
- Number of people with new/improved access to products/services that improve sanitation
- Amount of water conserved through water use efficiency or reduced water demand (in liters)
- Amount of water recycled and/or safely reused (in liters)
- Number of businesses created
- Number of jobs created
- Amount of new revenue generated in USD
- Amount of cost savings generated in USD
