
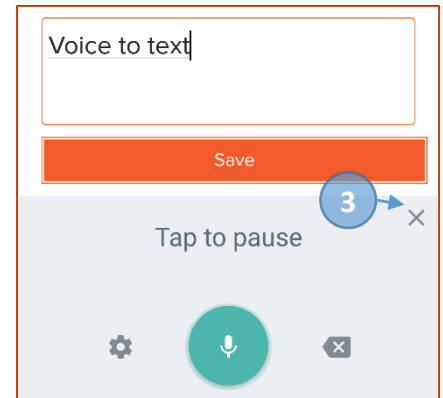
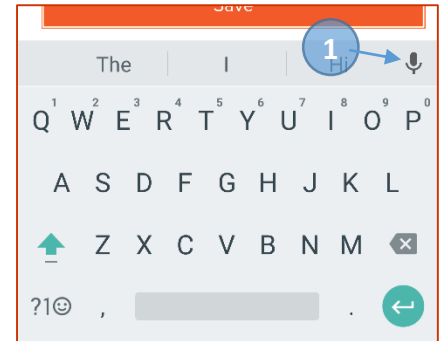


Using Speech to Text in Android

Setup

In a window that requires keyboard input with the virtual keyboard visible:

1. Select the **Microphone Button**. 
2. Speak clearly into the device. From the cursor you will see your words appear on the screen.
3. When finished with Speech to Text press **X**.
4. To return to the Speech to Text – tap in the text area to bring up the virtual keyboard and press the **Microphone Button**.



Tip see the table below to use voice commands for basic text and formatting control.

Command	Action
Period	= period (.)
Comma	= comma (,)
Question mark	= question mark (?)
Exclamation or exclamation point	= exclamation point (!)
Apostrophe	= apostrophe (')
Enter or new line	= moves to a new line
New paragraph	= new paragraph
Tab key	= tab
Colon	= colon (:)
Dash	= dash (-)

Command	Action
Ellipsis or dot dot dot	= ellipsis (...)
Ampersand	= ampersand (&)
Asterisk	= asterisk (*)
At sign	= at sign (@)
Backslash	= backslash (\)
Forward slash	= forward slash (/)
Open bracket	= open bracket ([)
Close bracket	= closed bracket (])
Open parenthesis	= open parenthesis ((
Close parenthesis	= close parenthesis ())
