suit	<i>common noun, sin- gular</i>	a set of clothes that usually consists of a jacket and a skirt or pair of pants that are made out of the same material
play	<i>common noun, sin- gular</i>	a piece of writing that tells a story through the actions and words of characters and that is performed on a stage

drop off	<i>phrase</i>	to go and leave someone at a certain place
no way	<i>phrase</i>	I cannot do it, it is not possible
lend	<i>principle verb, present simple</i>	to give (something) to (someone) to be used for a period of time and then returned
