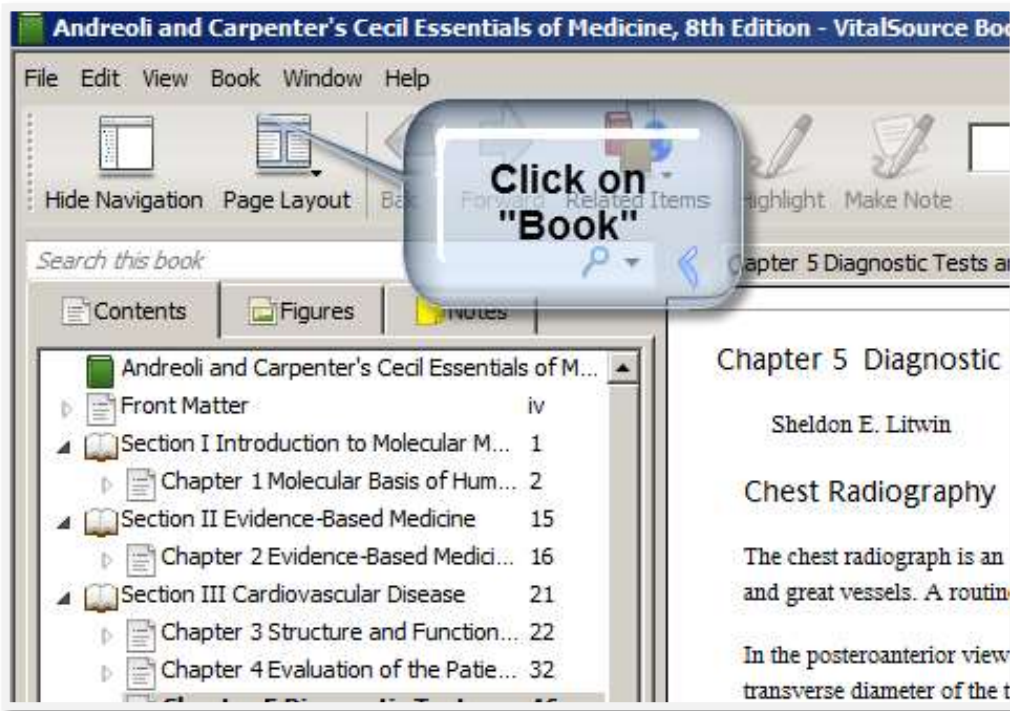
Start/Pause Text to Speech

The Text to Speech function can now be started and paused from either the pull-down menu or by using the keyboard shortcuts.

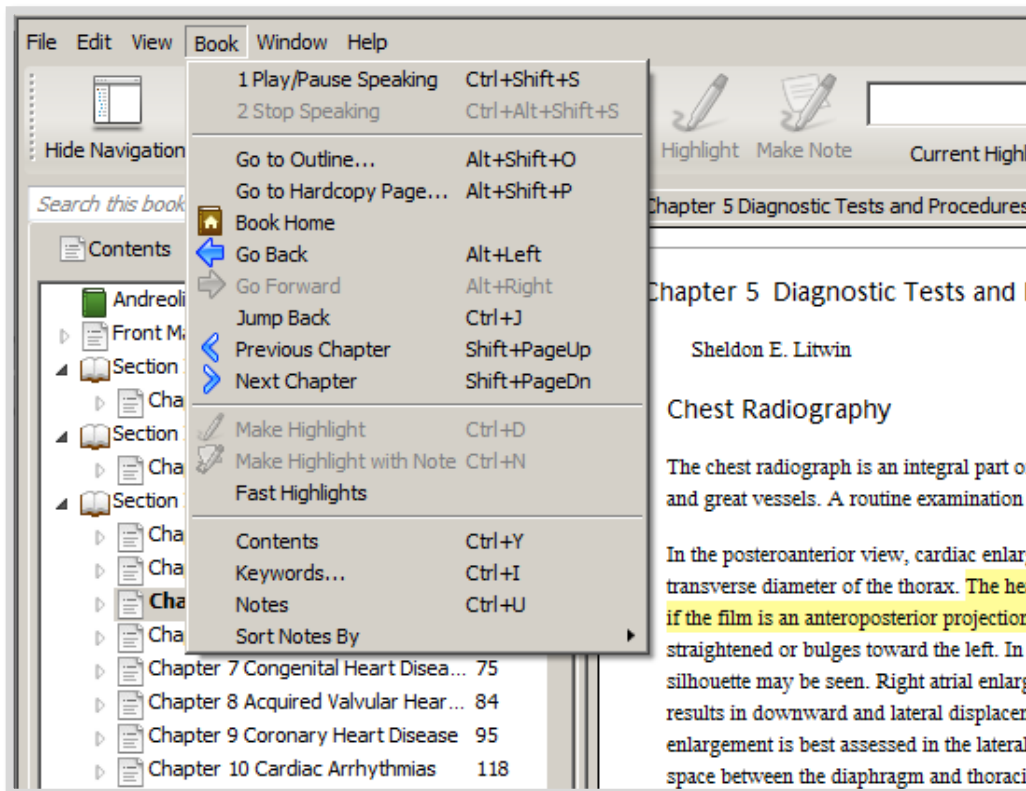
- 1) Position the cursor at the beginning of the chapter or highlight the text needed to be read aloud.



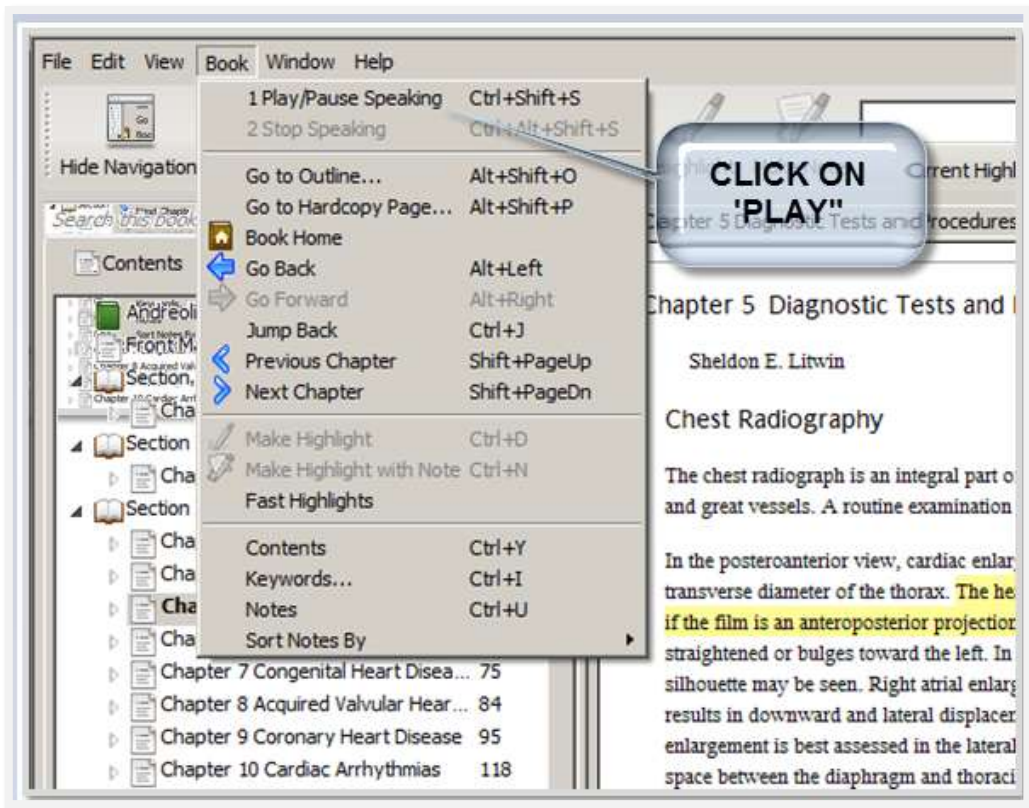
2) Go to toolbar and click on "Book".



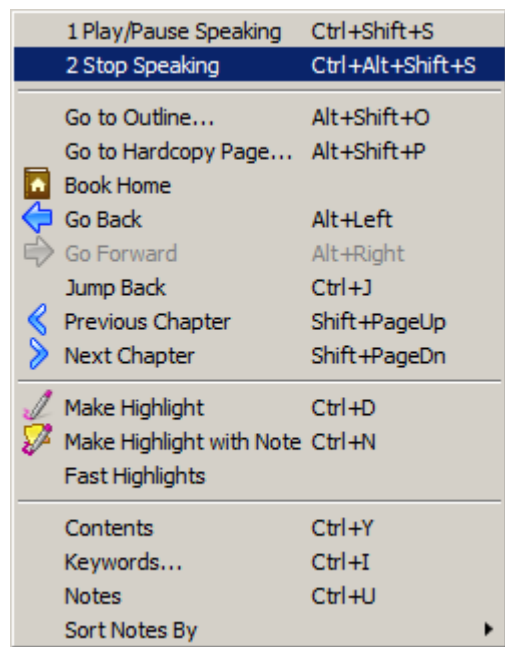
3) This will open the pull down menu.



4) Click "Play/Pause" or press "Ctrl+Shift+S" to start and pause the text to speech functions.



5) Click "Stop Speaking" or press "Ctrl+Alt+Shift+S" to stop the text to speech function.

Resolved file corruption issues when resuming an interrupted partial book download.

[Sign In Errors](#)

Bookshelf will now prompt a user to sign in when the user's credentials have not been cached, have been lost, or are corrupted.

[Booklist Update Error](#)

Bookshelf will now provide error messages when it has problems updating a user's book list.

[Multiple Accounts](#)

Books downloaded to the Shared Books folder will now have the file permissions set appropriately so they can be read by other Windows accounts on the same computer.

[Notes Improvements](#)

Improvements were made to the note synchronization to improve reliability.

Note ownership is now validated to prevent unauthorized changes being made to the note.

The change highlight command will not appear in the context menu if the items selected are a mix of owned and subscribed items.
