A. The physical pain and mental anguish James Hughes has sustained in the past;

C. Medical care expenses that James Hughes has sustained in the past;

Answer: \$ 430,000.00

E. Loss of earnings in the past;

Answer: \$ 30,000.00

F. Loss of earnings in the future;

G. Physical impairment suffered by James Hughes in the past;

H. Physical impairment suffered by James Hughes in the future;
