ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This civil action was commenced by a Complaint filed, under seal, pursuant to the *qui tam* provisions of the False Claims Act, 31 U.S.C. § 3730, by *qui tam* relator Henry W. "Buster" Roderigas. Pending before the Court is the Notice of Partial Intervention by the Government in this currently sealed civil action.

Pursuant to the Government's Notice of Partial Intervention, Rule 41(a)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, section 3730(b)(1) of the False Claims Act, 31 U.S.C. § 3730(b)(1), and the settlement agreement executed by the parties to this action, with good cause having been shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complaint filed by relator Henry W. Roderigas in this action is dismissed in its entirety, with prejudice, as to relator Henry W. Roderigas;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint filed by relator Henry W. Roderigas in this action is dismissed, with prejudice, as to the United States acting on its on behalf, only with respect to those averments and claims for relief in Count I of the Complaint which allege that one or more of the defendants submitted or caused to be submitted inflated claims for hours worked by employees of one or more of the defendants and thereby overcharged the United States Army for hours worked by employees of one or more of the defendants for helicopter maintenance activities performed at Camp Taji, Iraq, during the period from on or about March 1, 2004, through on or about August 31, 2005;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint filed by relator Henry W. Roderigas in this action is otherwise dismissed, without prejudice, as to the United States acting on its own behalf, with respect to all other claims of the United States that are alleged in the Complaint;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint filed by relator Henry W. "Buster" Roderigas, Jr., the Notice of Partial Intervention filed by the United States, and Orders entered in this case be unsealed;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other previously filed pleadings, declarations, and materials, other than the Complaint, Notice of Partial Intervention, and Orders entered by the Court shall remain under seal and not be made public or served upon the defendants;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of this Order and the Government's Notice of Partial Intervention be provided to counsel for defendants by counsel for the Government; and


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court retains jurisdiction over the settlement agreement executed by and among the parties in this case.


