JUDGMENT

The above entitled case having come on for trial by jury before the undersigned and the issues having been duly tried, and the jury having rendered its verdict on a verdict form, it is, this 27th day of August 2010, ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

1. That judgment BE, and it hereby IS, entered in favor of plaintiff against defendants jointly and severally in the sum of six thousand two hundred dollars (\$6,200.00) for his inconvenience, lost benefits, and lost pay from October 22, 2003 through January 23, 2004.
2. That Judgment BE and hereby IS entered in favor of plaintiff against defendant CHUGACH SUPPORT SERVICES, INC. in the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) for punitive damages.
