In accordance with your letter of March 7, 2006, CACI submits the follow response to the information you reference in your database:

Ibrahim v. Titan:

- The Company believes strongly that the allegations of the complaint are false and is vigorously defending its hard earned reputation against the malicious and damaging allegations of this suit. The Company notes that the complaint fails to present any information linking any CACI employee to any claimed injury.

Saleh v. Titan:

- The Company absolutely rejects the idea that it was ever a party to any kind of conspiracy related to the actions of its personnel in Iraq and is vigorously defending its hard earned reputation against the malicious and damaging allegations of this suit. The Company notes that, although the complaint names CACI as a "Torture Conspirator" and alleges that the "Torture Conspirators" were responsible for plaintiffs' injuries, the complaint fails to present any information linking any CACI employee to any claimed injury.

The DOC Press Release:

- The DOC matter occurred in 1991. In our view, it is both inappropriate and misleading for POGO to maintain and promote access and use of such outdated data. The direction given by U.S. Air Force officers to representatives of the Department of Justice and CACI regarding selection criteria for the people to assign to a litigation support project involving travel within Saudi Arabia in 1991 was for the intended purpose of protecting the lives of those U.S. citizens.
